Phillips—Died at Tallahassee, Fla., Nov. 10th, Calvin C. Phillips, aged 87 years. He is survived by his widow and two daughters, Anna R. Randall and Emma A. Kirk, both of Scrabble. He was buried in the family vault, which he designed at the age of 85 years. The flags at Tallahassee were at half mast on the day of the funeral as a token of respect.

Up to 1875 Mr. Phillips resided in Fulton. In 1875 he was in charge of the architectural exhibit at the Philadelphia Centennial. He designed the Pennsylvania building at the Chicago Columbian exposition and during the Paris exposition he was in charge of the U. S. architectural exhibit. Ten years ago he removed to Florida.
